Calculating Empirical and Molecular Formulas

A compound consists of 80% carbon and 20% Hydrogen. What is its empirical formula? (Hint divide each % by the molar mass of the element) $\text{C} = 80/12 = 6.7$ $\text{H} = 20/1 = 20$ The ratio of 20 to 6.7 is 3 to 1 ($20/6.7 = 2.99$) so there are 3 times as many H as C atoms. The empirical formula is C_3H_8
