The LVVWD receives its water on a wholesale basis from the Southern Nevada Water Authority (SNWA), which operates two water treatment plants with a combined design capacity of 900 mgd (3.41 mil m 3 per day). The source of water is Lake Mead. The treatment train at both plants is nearly identical, consisting of ozone and direct filtration.

Diarrhoeal Diseases.
