Step 1. Vote to dissolve the cooperative. The members, and investment shareholders when applicable, can vote by a special resolution to dissolve if the cooperative has stopped doing business; or an interested person can apply to the Court for an order to dissolve the cooperative. Step 2. Sell all property and pay all debts

### Liquidate or dissolve a corporation, cooperative or ...

If your operating agreement does not specify a procedure, California's LLC Act allows you to dissolve an LLC if 50 percent or more of the members vote in favor of doing so. Document the vote in a resolution or meeting minutes and note whether the vote was unanimous. 2. File a Certificate of Dissolution.
