3 This tendency is of course much weaker in Standard German, which – in contrast to the dialects – has clear written norms (Schrödl et al. 2015: 182), but two different plural forms for one noun lemma are not entirely unusual in Standard German as well (e.g. *Ballons* or *Ballone* for the lemma *Ballon* 'balloon'; see Mörth & Dressler 2014 for further examples).
