

How To Document Heent

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(these nodes should all be checked during the HEENT and Neck exams). During the remainder of the physical, check the following node groups: axillary, epitrochlear, inguinal (You may want to examine these when you are doing the exam of that particular region of the body. Include the description of these nodal regions with the other nodes listed

1 THE HISTORY AND PHYSICAL (H & P)

Document any possible causes that may have triggered the incident. Example: No one else present. Attempting to leave bathroom. Floor was wet at doorway. Resident's shoes smooth on bottom and slick when wet. Initials: Indicate initials of person completing the what/where/who/why portion of form.

Assesment&Alternative help guide - CMS

HEENT: Head: Normocephalic. Face, scalp and skull without lesions or tenderness. Eyes: Vision 20/40 in each eye. Conjunctivae without injection, sclera anicteric. Corneal light reflex symmetrical. PERRLA. Red reflex present bilaterally. Disc margins not appreciated, retinal vessels normal in appearance and configuration.

HEENT: Eyes - Extraocular movements are intact. Anicteric. ENT exam reveals moist mucous membranes. No posterior pharyngeal erythema. NECK: Negative for goiter or lymphadenopathy. Bilateral carotid bruits are noted . Cardiovascular: Regular rate and rhythm. S1 and S2. A II/VI systolic ejection murmur is noted at the right upper sternal border. .
