11 Fall Tasks for the Vegetable and Fruit Garden. Remove plant matter from the garden. Any spent vegetable plants, especially those that are killed by frost, should be removed immediately. Dead debris invites disease and insects. Chop beans and peas off at ground level, leaving their nitrogen-fixing roots in the soil to feed next year's crops.
